Club Activities

“Eyesight Roswell” Update – Alan Bethel

Roswell City Schools Eyeglass Program--The need and demand for eyeglasses continues at a high rate. In December, twelve students were helped by the Eyesight Roswell program through Alpharetta Eye Associates and Lenscrafters .

The situation with the 12 year old boy that has a serious eye condition of the optic nerve took several twists and turns since December. We had been asked by Alpharetta Eye Associates to arrange an appointment with a neuro-ophthalmologist. Dr. Robert Spector has been suggested by AEA. His office is willing to do an examination of the student at a cost of \$200-400, which is a reduced rate, and we agreed to go forward. The boy has recently been provided a pair of glasses through our program with AEA and Lenscrafters. We have been unable to contact the family to facilitate an appointment with Dr Spector. Jennifer Bui, Roswell City School social worker called on 1/8/07 and advised the family has moved and she doesn't have an address for them. She is searching for them and will let us know when she locates the family.

Jennifer Bui also advised of a student at Elkins Pointe MS that recently had an appointment with an ophthalmologist at Emory. He has very poor eyesight and his glasses are very thick but he still doesn't see that well with his glasses. The Emory Dr. is recommending a special contact lense for the student. His mother has \$250 of the \$450 needed for the contact lenses. Jennifer wondered if the Roswell Lions Club could pay the \$200? The family is on Medicaid and they will not pay for the contacts. It was agreed to support this new need.

Hearing Aid Program for SSNF-- We are setup with SSNF on the process to move forward with a hearing aid program. SSNF has two candidates for the program. We expect some activity to start in early 2007. If the client is unable to pay or can only pay for part of the services, we will help with the charges.

SSNF Eyeglass Program--As a follow-up to our November 14 eyeglass repair and vision testing visit with LC to SSNF, SSNF ran a story of the visit and our eyeglass program in their December "Sage" newsletter. The "Sage" newsletter highlighted the value of community partnerships which featured the Roswell Lions Club and had a story about the November 14 eyeglass repair and vision testing visit with LC. The newsletter is sent to 1800 clients and various people in Roswell and North Fulton Co. A copy of the "Sage" newsletter will be sent to you.

Health Fair at SSNF--The Health Fair at SSNF will be held in February with the specific date to be set. Lenscrafters will partner with us on the Health Fair. Acuity and glaucoma testing will be done.

Lenscrafters--We held an eyeglass repair and vision testing mission visit with LC to the Roswell Nursing & Rehabilitation Center on Green St. on January 9th. We were able to assist 12 residents. They have 200 residents so it will take several visits to cover the total resident population. We will cover 15-25 residents on future visits. This service is provided at no charge and was very well received by the residents and the administrative staff of Roswell Nursing & Rehab. There will be a need for eyeglasses here and we will need to decide how to proceed after a couple more visits and an ER committee meeting. This is another way for our Club to reach out in the community and serve those in need. We will have a presence on all of the repair and vision testing visits.

Foster Care Support Foundation-- This week we will be providing glasses for the first child from the FCSF program. Rachel Ewald, founder, advised of the need. We can channel the referrals from FCSF through Roswell Eye Clinic. There won't be that many referrals from FCSF.

Homestretch--The new director will be on board in January and a meeting could be held in late January/early February to introduce the program to Homestretch.

Roswell School Nurse Program--Contact has been made with the Director of School Nurse Program for Fulton Co and the cluster nurse for Roswell City Schools to make them aware of our Eyesight Roswell eyeglass program with the Roswell City Schools. They have been asked to be on the lookout for sight impaired students for our eyeglass program, as well as candidates for the Lions Camp for the Blind.

We continue to provide eye exams and eyeglasses to clients in need of support at the **Drake House** and **North Fulton Charities**.

Please advise if you have other ideas or suggestions. The Eyesight Roswell committee is made up of Bob Garrett and Alan Bethel, co-chairs, committee members, Earl Ake, Phil Farias, Jeff Hammen, Lewis Mason, Robby Robinson, Patsy Shuford, and Linda Spudic. It is the goal of the committee to keep our membership informed on the status and progress of this very important Roswell Lions program. We are making a difference in our community. Thanks.

Spotlight on Community Partnerships

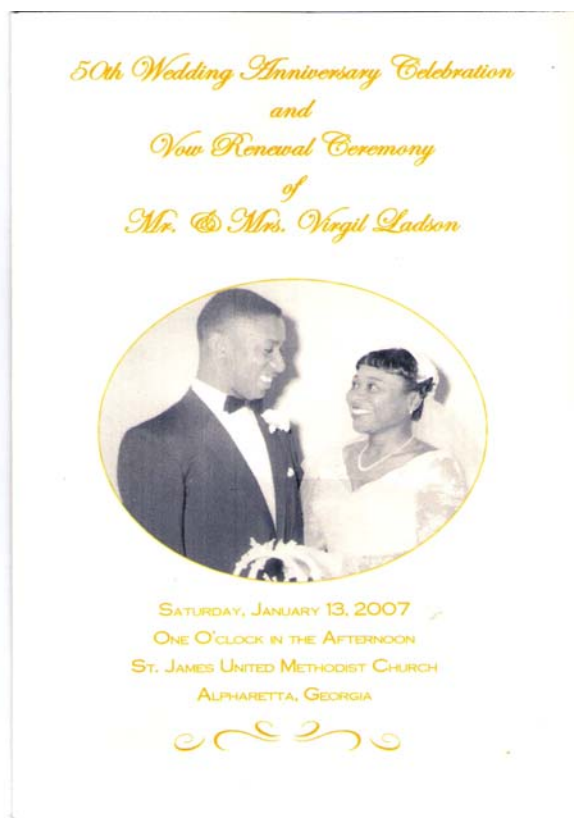
