Unless another Lion takes over the Fly the Flag Program, it will be terminated after flags are placed on Presidents' Day in 2010.

The program was started in 1998, and since that time, it has contributed \$9,928 to the projects of the Roswell Lions. The charge to place the flags has remained \$60 per location since the inception of the program and currently there are only twelve locations. We have placed the flags since the program started and at times, other members have helped if one of us had to miss a day.

Flags are placed on seven holidays and on 9-11 which is now known as Patriot Day. We placed the flags on the day of the attack on the World Trade Center and have placed them on every September 11 since then. Columbus Day was also added when it was recognized that some merchants are closed on many other holidays and did not see the flags at their locations,
