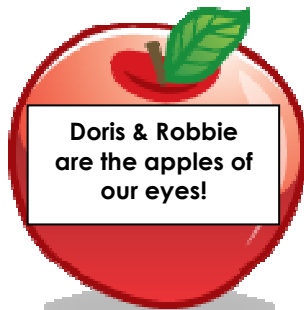


Successful Apple Sale 2010

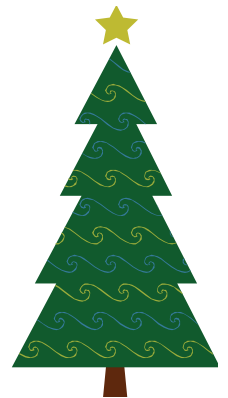
